The idea for a province-wide week of appreciation originated with The Bhayana Family Foundation, in partnership with United Way of Greater Toronto and the Ontario Nonprofit Network. *Bill 9 – An Act to Proclaim a Week of Appreciation for the Nonprofit Sector* was championed by MPP Daisy Wai through a Private Members Bill, and unanimously passed late last year. The Nonprofit Sector Week of Appreciation takes place the third week of February in perpetuity.

Ontario's nonprofit sector is the largest in Canada, employing 844,000 people across 58,000 organizations. According to the <u>Ontario Nonprofit Network</u>, the sector contributes 7.9% to our province's GDP, constituting \$65.4 billion in economic impact.
